Water supplied by the Stamford Water Co. through 2 lines of cement & iron pipe, 12" & 16", from Cox's Dam, on Mill River, 6 miles north of Central Park, elevation 171 feet above tide water. Trinity Lake, capacity 300 Million Galls, serves as a reserve reservoir. Connection soon to be made with Mead's Pond, of same capacity as Trinity Lake.

100 Double Hydrants, 4"; 1 Quadruple Hydrant, 4"; at Central Park, 44 Miles of Water Pipes, Average Pressure 45 to 61 lbs. per Sq. Inch.
